# Monotheism



Both Christianity and Judaism believe in the existence of

ONE GOD

the Creator and Ruler of the Universe.



Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one.

Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength.

#### The Hebrew Bible



Both Christianity and Judaism regard the Hebrew Bible as a sacred text.
Containing foundational scripture, stories, laws, and teachings.

#### Covenant


Both believe in the concept of covenant between God and Humanity.

Judaism: Between God and the Jewish People at Mount Sinai.

Christianity: Covenant fulfilled through Jesus.

## Ethical Monotheism

Both emphasize ethical conduct and moral principles as essential aspects of faith.



The Ten Commandment are central to both traditions.

## Messiah

Shared belief in the coming of a Messiah who will bring salvation and redemption.

Admitted differences in interpretations of the concept.

**Christians: Jesus is the Messiah** 

Judaism: Still awaiting the coming in the future.

## Eschatology- End times theology

Both have beliefs about the end times and the fate of humanity.



Shared expectation of final judgement and future restoration (renewal) of the world.

Admitted differences in details.

**Both honor the** prophets of the **Hebrew Bible as** messengers of God conveying divine revelation and guidance.
